Hattie. Roy & Emily are coming here in the afternoon Margorie
cleared up swept. bath-rooms & I baked an apple sauce cake &
cookies with jelly on & a few custard pies Hattie was over
for tea. she drove them home
Friday 25. Margorie went in to Eddie's for the day. I churned &
washed a lot of starched things. Paul took shirt among them
Marguerite came home after school from Clifton. I made another
applesauce cake in bake while I was ironing Margorie came
Sat 26. Margorie went in Clifton took 10 lb butter @ 22 250 & 5 doz
eggs @ 22, brought home the boxes for bee house frame could not pay
so she bought the groceries she youngsters went in Montague
party. Will & Lilly went in Drummondville. they had the road
traces on the road yesterday the big swarm that came out
& went back in the patent hive came out & I worked pretty nearly
all day with it & one over in Will orchard a good thing
I had so much of my work done yesterday Paul came home
from camp had his dinner a Dralmsleys. I made 3 custard pie
jelly tarts

Sun 27. a nice breeze from the east all at once it was gone but
stung up at night. again the children's father arrived when
it was the hottest. he brought 6 dollars. Paul took him as far
as Perre's at night. it was quite cool then Arthur took Hattie
in the brick. Will's bees swarmed & over that swarmed yesterday
came out of the hive I went over there & went in the house with their
Hattie over in the evening & gave the children their Sunday school
Mon 28. Margorie washed her ~~thing~~ ^{trousers} mostly things in starch
Marguerite did not go to school she guarded the cows. I churned
an awful hot day. I let the out of the pen had he watch her
had he his her up again as they are going to draw manure from
her. Will. Arthur & Paul & her wagon. the teacher called
Tue 29. beautiful cool day I dressed the rooster for dinner
made two tins of biscuits & 2 custard pies the teacher & Hattie
for dinner they furnished the manure here. I packed a little
crock of butter the crock that weighs 3 lb for Aden there was butter
enough for 1.32 she got at all in sugar & 1 1/2 doz eggs @ 20 pr doz
on bread. Wed 30 Hattie & her father went in Hattie's after straw
berries got in a half crate they 1/3 pr crate & Paul got us one
they got two Arthur & Paul gone with a load of hay to Aden
I'll. I had a swarm of bees out of the hive that I'm going
& towards night a lady swarm came & Paul hived it after he
threw. I churned. Emma's Ross called Arthur & Paul to a straw
berry festival a Clarktons last night one of the beautiful
nights you would wish to be so cool & bright we had all
berries we wanted in cream for supper I stayed up until
20 min in 12 & finished cleaning them & weighed them & put
the sugar on them after they were washed
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
