ECLIPSES IN 1854.

There will be only two Eclipses this year, both of the Sun, and neither visible in the Atlantic States.

I.—A central Eclipse of the Sun May 5th.

II.—An annular Eclipse of the Sun, October 30th, invisible in the United States except in New Mexico and Texas.

THE SEASONS.

Vernal Equinox,.....March 20.
Summer Solstice,.....June 20.
Autumnal Equinox,...September 22,
Winter Solstice,.. ..December 21.

MORNING AND EVENING STARS.

Venus will be Morning Star until July 18th, then Evening Star the rest of the year. Mars will be Morning Star until Aug. 18, then Evening Star the rest of the year. Jupiter will be Morning Star until Feb. 15, then Evening Star until Nov. 30. Saturn will be Morning Star until Jan. 8, then Evening Star until Oct. 13, then Morning Star the rest of the year.
