Frost last night: cold morning got warmer sunny. We hauled in some corn and plowed up 6 rows potatoes in A.M. Willie also took the load turnips down to Beattie we got in last night 77 bushels. In P.M. Jim Fernald and me picked potatoes Willie plowed 5 rows No 2 till about 5 o'clock. Girls down town P.M. got Mary's hat Beattie's 325 meat Mills 45. Paid J. Fernald 35^{cts}

Fine sunny day warm. We hauled in corn and potatoes in A.M. and in P.M. we all went to show, expenses 50^{cts} Girls and Willie at home for supper Frank Dodge there.

Mr Mc Lintk Elm preached from 1 Corint. 11:26 congregational
meeting after decided to give our minister \$12.00. Got Nellie shod front
feet at loadys in fee 25 got meat Mills 40. We hauled in
mangels 3 horses in turnip box
