This afternoon, found her very poorly, not likely to recover. Called at Dr. King's got 6 qts goose berries. 70 2 1/2 yds print 2.

20 Marion & I went to see Aunt Flora left in morning when we got home we found Birdie off to Hattie's. They sent for her in the morning. Sugar 1. 07

21 Making preserves. Got wood that Kelly did yesterday at 11. a m. To buy at Shedd 50

22 Three funerals announced to day, Robert Dugald, from Andrew Hall's, Walter Smith from back of Martintown died in B. C. be buried here, and Mrs D. G. will be buried in St Lancaster Rd Murdy went to Sally's

23 Fine day. Murdy cut the home meadows and some on the farm I worked in the garden

24 Birdie came home last evening. Hattie and a John Robert McCannan came up with her I got at McCannan's. 1 lb currants 10. 1/4 lb codon 20
1 qt B. St. sup 14. 1 can salmon 15. at Hillie's 31
1 lb clean currants. Cousin Mary sent 1 pair berries

25 There was rain through the night, and a drizzle all forenoon. Murdy cleaned the kitchen. Bird cooked the berries. To 100 flour at McCannan 2.25. get 5

26 Looks like rain. Murdy went north, took Kattie. Had Whilford and Pidgeon. This afternoon put in three loads of hay, 2 from home meadow 1 from farm. Birdie is at J's washing feathers. To sugar 31. Annie John gave us a mess of new potatoes

27 Whilford and Pidgeon working in afternoon, put in three loads of hay

28 Murdy came at 10 P.M. last night. A very fine day there will be plenty of hay put in today
70 24 lbs steak 26

29 Sunday. Fine day, very hot. About 87 Reaching in the Hall, some visitors to preaching, Mural Hunt - Dan Mc Laurin East river, Rev A Scott's family & visitor Mrs Cabell McKae of Brooklyn N. Y. and her cousin Mr Loney took tea with us

30 Heard this morning that Maggie Henan died at her nephew's Dan Percell, last night she went to Cornwall to the Hotel Due a week Saturday. she will be buried here tomorrow in St Mary's Pot at Hillie's 1 glass pitch 25
1 can brown 25. sugar 50. black dye 10 35
2 bars soap 10

31 Was at Maggie Henan's funeral, not many present. I heard that she committed suicide by drowning at her nephew's Dannie Percell, place on the front St. Lawrence. I had two letters from Jimmie today, both written early in June. he got no letter since leaving Blount Mountain
