 it is Plunado from Cornwall
 the Lucias fishing Richerell and
 a little not very well 8th fine hot
 mowing at the South side of the
 Potatoes Blackbirds very bad at
 the oats chicken Hawks came
 High & Wind Rained Rained to night
 The Algerian aground the Rocket
 took her Passengers to Montreal
 Algerian Late going Down 9th
 fine & Wind changed to west mowing
 in the upper field turning the oats
 Lucias for Butter Lewis for milk
 and Butter seen a Big fine last
 night away Back East Mr Gene
 came 10th cutting hay above the same
 putting in the oats all that is ripe
 in the West part of the upper field
 gathering and coring the calf pasture
 and part of the upper field Mr Gene
 helping us 11th fine & W began
 a Stack Mr Gene at the Stack
 the Rocket aground coming into
 Lancaster Bohemian went up
 Mr Barnes Mr Cartney here

 Lewis and his 2 Boys here Boys for
 Butter Rocket went up the 2 fields
 and Stanley went to Hamilton
 heard about the Row the migger
 had at Stanley Island 13th mowed
 the oats down on the Hill Mr
 Gene went off mowed the oats
 at the Grove Stanley and I went
 to fish Perch got 20 fine warm
 14th a very fine day cut the oats in
 the upper field cut some hay
 Raking Annie went off Lewis
 and Stanley put her across to
 take the Boat the Richelieu
 mowed a Road in the Rushes
 in the front Marsh yesterday
 eat a lot of new corn she crossed
 on the Richelieu 15th Rained Thunder
 and Lightning fine cut some hay the
 Boats going Down with lots of Soldiers
 or Passengers sawed some wood
 finished the fine hay in the upper field
 cutting it began the oak field 16th
 very fine day finished putting in the
 Oats mowing in the oak field
 caught a nice little Bird 17th fine hot
 began mowing the Back Marsh
 mowing in the oak field took
 a Tub of Butter to Jo Douche
