21 Saturday killed 3 young cocks, gave one to Miss  
Mughart for picking two burry fleeces of lambs  
wool. Pa & Murdy went to Lancaster and got  
7 yds of cloth to make Murdy a suit

22 Sat today I did not go to church. Hatty did  
not get a chance of a ride. Given preacher  
today.

23. Rained all night. Jimmie drove Hatty  
to her school, then took the team and  
drove Murdy to the Gore Station, and  
called at Uncle Donald's for a scraper  
I washed but did not hang out the  
white clothes, got just 5 cts 2 blouses

24 Rained all last night and driz-  
gled all this day now 8 P.M. night  
dark & cold high wind, I baked  
in oven, Jimmie ditching by the lane  
on farm

25 Pretty fine day. Jimmie & Ran finished the  
lane in forenoon. Jimmie went in afternoon  
to the funeral of Annie Ross, S. E. of River Run  
west of McCallum's. Ran was at a party  
last night at W. C. Maple Hill. There was  
a little snow today. I sent his coat to  
Far to Woodstock. By express. 10 cts to Maul  
carrier, got 2 spools silk thread at J. G.'s 10  
got cloth at Willis for Murdy's over coat 10  
5 yds 83.425. Mummy came 4.15 (coat & vest) 8.40

26 Bidie went to the B. river school. The promoti-  
on is going on, got 1 gall wal oil, Jimmie  
was putting a floor in part of the cow  
stable. Got 1 1/2 yd waist lining for Marn  
jacket sleeves, 1 1/4 yd farmers button  
I saw by today's papers that Lord Bulwer  
Lytton was dead. died suddenly in France
