Saturday August 5<sup>th</sup>

It just rained enough this morning to keep us from getting out at the alsike for an hour or so. Dad and I went out and blocked up some more holes under the fence where the sheep get through on to Ben Loeys. We then started to thrash some of my wheat out as they wanted the report to-day if possible. Dad thought it would be

too tough to flail out so we did it with our hands. It was an awful job. It took us till noon to rub out and clean one sheaf the Banathes. I don't think we got as much sud back as we sowed but it was nice quality. This afternoon we hauled in two loads of alsike but it bulks up so it hardly makes a hole in the field. To night I went down to Auntie's and went for a swim in the creek and then up to the dance and had quite a time. Aunt was there and was very anxious to go to Victoria tomorrow to see the Mrs. Robinsons that are there from B.C. so he drove up with the Dunkin girls and I don't know whether he stayed there all night or not. I think he intended to. I rode up with them pretty early to Pat's Boyper's and then walked home getting here about two o'clock or soon after. H.H.
