- Wed Jan 30. <sup>29</sup> Rained last night and slippery again. Doctor here.
- Thur Jan 31. <sup>30</sup> Colder and icy. a fine day. I called at Mrs Watson's.
- Fri Feb 1. Fine and moderately cold. Mrs Davidson and I curling.  
Annie here in the evening.
- Sat Feb 2. Snowing steadily all morning. then turned to light  
rain about two o'clock. Bear did not see shadow
