Elizabeth & I and Far went to see Aunt Kate Marjory
is still alive but very weak

Mary M. Dulyer came here last evening Elizabeth
went off today

Mary & I went to Prayer Meeting Jimmie is bad
with toothache and head ache. we are
going to Cornwall tomorrow. Aunt Annie & I have
to go to receive our legacies

We went to Cornwall Peter John Fergusson drove us
Duncan & Jimmie went with us. Jimmie had four teeth filled
and the dentist tried to pull a back tooth but could
not he broke it off the filling was \$5.40

I got \$5.87 1/2 of interest on \$700 = Bought at Kirkpatrick
10 yds shirting 100. 12 yds check \$2.04. 1 neck tie 50
1 pair B.K. gloves 100. 1 silk Kerchief 75 cts 1 patch 100
3 yds Cashmere 1.35 2 yds selice 44. 2 1/2 yard lining 37
1 doz spools thread 4¢ = at Druggist Hall 100 = 100
1 doz lemons 25 music 5

We paid \$2.50 for the team 75 cts for dinner
It is well we went yesterday to Cornwall for it
is stormy. Evening a great deal of snow

got syrup 20 cts ginger 5 cts
Sunday still stormy Thursday & Friday 25 each

Stormed until midnight it cold today
