

Thursday 29th Oct 1903

We finished topsoiling turnips
this morning & harrowed
5 up & hauled loads in afternoon
gave mother n. check for \$5.00 5.00

Friday, 30th fine
We worked at turnips all
day got in 14 loads put
14 in roothouse & 5 in pit
had Joe, Mr Grogan
helping us at, 50¢ per
day. got St Louis prize
list today

Saturday 31st fine
We worked at turnips
26th all day had J. Flick 1/2 day
90¢ C. & H. Smith 1 day, Joe
50 Mr Grogan 1 pd J^m Grogan 1.00 1.00
Charley Smith 50¢ Harry, 10¢ 50

Sunday 1st Nov 1903 fine
Father Mother & I went
to Church in morning
& Mary Children & I went up
to Don's after dinner
gave check for \$10.00 for imp fund
which completes my subscription
10.00
Monday, 2nd fine

We worked at turnips, got
8 in 8 loads. I took two
Ewe lambs up to Don's and
then arranged for him
to come & help us with
x wire fence, Elm Park Belle's
had bull calf today by Prince
of Benton,

Tuesday 3rd fine
We finished hauling turnips
and plowed up carrots
& started to cover pit
also hauled home 1/2 loads
1 Cabbages & one load of turnips

Wednesday 4th fine
We finished taking up
roots, two loads carrots
finished, covering turnip
pits, Don here all day, I went
to Ram Hair pd Bollert's bill. 540 540
