- 1 Wednesday, fine cool day, got a straw hat at Mother Rounis 50
- 2 Woman's Meeting at the Manse not many present 9 or 10 we had snow frost last night, and it is cold this evening. Mrs Lumbry came to the kitchen \$3.00 per man
- 3 Some days cold yet - Gordon is painting the Kulluit block got beef 45 cts
- 4 Sandy finished today he got 1.50 per day
- 5 Sunday, fine day pretty warm
- 6 Pa went to The Springs this morning, I got 38 lb 2.00 sugar at Dan's 3 yds stuff for overalls 75
- 7 Boys mowing oats, got at Dan's 1 lb tea 45 45
1/4 lb salts yesterday & today were very hot
Uncle Donald had sheep killed by dogs
Saturday night, I preserved plums yesterday 20 lbs
- 8 I did not go to prayer meeting this evening, I get very hoarse about sun-down Mr M Gillavry is to go off tomorrow for Toronto & Collingwood
- 9 Thursday, rained some in forenoon, boys digging ditch below the garden, the Mill came to the MacGuchy farm this evening Peter Francis's Mill worked by two Roydon's boys
- 10 Threshed some oats & 3 bush wheat - There is some kind of a shew in the village tonight, Mrs Grant & Mary were in for a while this evening
- 11 The O. L. C. had quite a disappointment today the L. C. of Huntington were to have come to play a friendly game, but could not and did not telegraph until 10 o'clock this forenoon
The boys did not get through thrashing
