 and I audited books Melville church. We got home
 about 2 A.M. May down town got grain traps 16cts
 Mr. Sess over got 2 back jobs to make a flail.

 and I audited books in J. Beeth's office. I deposited
 \$2.25 B.S. money in Inf. Bank 117 Bristol of \$2.00 jan 1909
