cloudy day ground white with snow
frosty got stormy at night. Willie took 1098
lbs cow chop and 764 lbs pig chop to Cartons
brought it up also 50 tiles Hamilton got Jack
~~shod at Simpson's~~ got at Mannis oil & oil
can 10 nails 12 separator oil Simpson's map 10 ds.
In P.M. Willie plowed sod No 2 E I closed
doors of pig pen straw and boards to get ready for winter
Miss Daley and Bob Indale down in evening.

Tuesday

Cold frosty cloudy day. I went over to Gulls
then to Keith looking for a room got a lamb room
at Keith's paid \$8.00 for it. In P.M. Willie
plowed in No 2 E sod I laid 17 more tiles cellar drain.

14

Wednesday

Frosty fine day sunny P.M. We brought over two
loads manure in A.M. and Willie plowed in P.M.
No 2 E. I worked at drain. Bella and I went down
to B. society meeting our church at night. Col 15 ds
Mr Smith Methodist minister of Guelph addressed
the meeting. Bella got at Stab's spool 5 ds groceries
(including bag flour \$2.50) \$3.40 pd.

Thursday

15

Frosty cloudy fine. Willie brought up two loads
manure from ^{also 50 tiles in Hamilton} ~~Dumfries~~ spread in No 1 and one
from Stab's in No 5 got Jack shod Simpson's 60 ds
I worked at drain. Willie wheeled down at night
to Milne get suit fitted. Mr Sars over in evening with
Plymouth Rock Harter paid him 40 ds for it. he helped me
put rack in wagon.
