Poison Ivy.

1. To prevent further penetration of poison: Soap and hot water bath of whole body; discard all clothing exposed to the poison. 2. To relieve itching, water as hot as can be borne. 3. Curative remedies: Ichthyol collodion, 5 per cent., painted on lesions three times daily. Magnesium sulphate in saturated solution, applied on gauze, covered with rubber tissue and bandage. Iodine tincture, diluted with 9 parts of water. Hot 2 per cent. (or weaker) potassium permanganate solution; remove stain with 1 per cent. oxalic acid solution. 4. Where pustules have formed: Hot mercuric chloride solution.—Von Adelung.

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
