Mr Mills Cameron Island 5<sup>th</sup> July  
Uncle John's B Day 1803 Fine  
Day Seander to Dundee Water high  
and raising some E Wind went up to the  
Bay Stanley and I put a Bottom to a  
Bosc Bought of Lime & scythes 1.30  
Seander to Summervtown to night  
6<sup>th</sup> a very warm Day finished putting  
the Plough through the Potatoes Lewis  
& Boys here for milk and Butter grew  
the Logs up a little with the Mare  
Taking the stems of the Potatoes  
Used a Leg on the Bench sawed some  
wood a Man at the Fishermens from  
Alexandria Seander Mowed some to  
try the scythes 7<sup>th</sup> Fine warm Mowed  
the grove and a Road to the Back  
of the Barn and a Road to the cherries  
as they are getting Ripe Put Poles green  
on the Lower Peice of Potatoes Those  
Fishermen from Lancaster to payent  
from Monday last 4<sup>th</sup> of July as they  
came up to Day to speak to me about  
it
