 at Martin's went PM to see 153 rd got presented with colors with I.A. Willie Howard come in No 5. I milre up PM pulled mangles they got in 2 small loads. Arthur and wife up for tea I drove them down at night took boys to mill to get oats chd in, gave Arthur's wife eggs 50cts for what May owed her. Wm Clark eggs 64cts 50 50 ~~50~~ 64

Saturday

Frost last night. fine sunny day. Willie plowed some AM No 5. I plowed out 4 rows potatoes with Ellen digger. I milre finished mangles this AM went home after dinner we paid him in full. PM Willie went down got at mill 120 lbs. westerly oats dropped 25.55
 105 gave cheque on I.B for 30.55 got 55.00 back from Wilson he also brought up 1300 lbs. oats from F & S on 4 got at mill bran 1.40
 PM we picked the 4 rows potatoes and brought in rest of mangles one load Willie met Fieslie Patterson on Orangeville road with black roan calf. we bought from him this AM gave cheque 8.02 I.B.
 Mackie over at night to tell us Hethaway had given 3627 him an offer for his place with the Henry Johns house in the deal. valued at \$500.00
