- 1 Sabbath Fine day, a large congregation, I went to see Auntie after prayer meeting. There was a report that Emily Beauchamp died last night, but it was contradicted.
- 2 Morning looked gloomy, and like rain but cleared up beautifully, high wind blowing the musquitos into corners Jimmie ploughed the lot by the barn it is quite wet, sowed mangolds and radishes Mrs Russell paid rent, Pa paid Auntie \$45.⁰⁰
- 3 Fine day, heavy rain
- 4 I went to see Auntie after Prayer Meeting, she is excited about the election.
- 5 The election is going on, Murdy went to vote so did Clark, Jimmie is poll clerk here 5 P.M. I got ready to go to Womens meeting at J. Dingwells R.R. but it rained all afternoon I went to call on Mrs W. Shack about 4 P.M. 8 P.M. Reynolds is likely the chosen, he has now a majority
- 7 Bridie went to Lancaster last evening and got 1 pair boots
- 8 A very fine day, not many in church, Pa was down at Murdys
- 9 Fine day, I do not feel very well
- 10 Another fine day, Ran, washed the blankets it began to rain about 6 o'clock
- 11 rain again
- 13 Friday rained heavily
- 14 Rain again, Jim Murdy & Ben went to Lancaster to Lacrosse, I was sick all afternoon, got 72 lb tea 33cts, sugar 25, blacking 5, 42 lb rassin 5 grand
- 15 I was very sick last night am better today
- 16 Fine day, made a large washing, 2 yds cotton 52
1 1/2 yds cotton 9-14-2 doz hooks & eyes, 4 gave peas today
- 17 Jimmie & Murdy hoeing potatoes
