in 3 sashes 2<sup>oz</sup> Bloker's Bonny  
Best Tomato in 1 $\frac{1}{2}$  sashes

1<sup>oz</sup> S. Buggs Bonny Best in  
1 $\frac{1}{2}$  sashes. and 6<sup>oz</sup> of  
John Baer. 16 sashes in all  
Pat Boyd grafting yet,  
grafted Prunes on about  
a dozen monarchs! also  
finished, about 20 cherry

trees (sweet) and all  
the Kieffer pears, 6 Rows  
Bartletts,  $\frac{1}{2}$  Row Anjou  
2 $\frac{1}{2}$  Rows. Clarigow  
looks like a storm again  
tonight.

march 10<sup>th</sup>. light shower  
this morning, fine +  
warm like Spring rest  
of day, another thunder  
of Shofner after supper,  
trimming trees.

march 11<sup>th</sup>. colder today  
they have had a big  
blizzard + snow storm  
in the northwest. train  
blocked yesterday. Pat  
Boyd finished grafting  
trees, cost \$60.00
