here gave Him a 10 Dollar
cheque Dan Spink here Ed Penshaw
Gordon John He here Fished Elks
28th Fine Last Day of the Month
Mrs Lewis and her Mother Here
Mrs Lewis stopt to Wash
stopt all Day Paid Her 50 cents
Gave her a Basket of Potatoes
Got 10 Dollars from Sissy
