August 16 Ad & Wallace helped Bruce with his harvest  
fine warm day I tared my boats

17 Ad & Wallace helped Bruce & F Jones held  
a meeting in the drill shed at 5 o'clock on the finances  
of the Country there was about 100 persons present  
at night  
Rev W. Nichols preached this morning W. Gornet at night

19 Ad & Wallace helped Bruce to look peas & sowed  
timothy & clover seed on the North East field where  
we had oats from the potatoes to the first ridges of wheat

20 Ad went to the C concession to see the oats there  
they are fit to cut they helped Bruce in the afternoon

21 Ad & Wallace helped Bruce to stock his peas  
Sunnet & me went to Horvost home dinner of the  
Methodist Church here in drill shed there was about  
one hundred 50 cents each George Taylor chair

22 Ad. Wallace & Bruce went to the C concession  
& cut & brought home 2 loads of oats that was  
it all they took the catts out & left them there

23 Ad went to the funeral of David Johnson he is  
buried in there near of Sandown he died in gonorrhea  
Wallace got Mrs. McViel's horses & went to gonorrhea  
for Bissie & Aunt Sunnet they came on the boat  
from Toronto had a fine time

24 Lizie come from young at noon Ad did  
not get home last night he staped a young  
cow

25 Rev W. Gornet preached this morning & A. W. Frazer at night I was taken  
with cold chill last night & was sick all night I could not leave my bed

26 Ad tried to plow in the summer fallow the ground is so wet he could  
do nothing he went to gonorrhea with the wood 3 1/2 bushel of shandy  
seed paid 2.40 per bushel I am not able to say how much

27 Ad drew 3 loads of wood from Bruce it is too windy to saw  
gonorrhea

28 Ad & Wallace sowed the large field next Calhaugen  
with clover & timothy & the remainder of our sowing field

29 Ad tried to plow in the summer fallow it is too wet  
sentle Rab come up for Aunt Sunnet Ellen went down with  
the

30 Ad & Wallace worked at the Celler Georgey & Jerome came  
from Pary sowed this morning on the C concession

31 Grandy took Bessie to Farmerwike & Miss Turner she is going  
to school then Jerome went home with them Ad went to gonorrhea  
- just to have Mrs. King & Catherine they are to lecture there since  
then I am not able to do any thing yet
