of better \$10.50 insurance charge for R 13 stamp 2 1/2 cts

We spread 6 loads manure got 15 more
drill turnips sowed also fertilized it. Willie
down at noon We all down at night.

Rain last night. Cloudy some sunshine

We spread 8 loads manure on A.D. Ireland
and put spreader away. P.M. we went down
home stayed down all night.

Sunday

Fine sunny day cool. Father died
this morning about 4 o'clock aged 86 years
2 months and one day. I walked over told Mr. Brown
also Wm. Thompson who came up. I went down
with him to choose casket they brought it
