windy & looks like snow now 11:40  
A. M. Pa & Jimmie are with Peleew  
he brought our flour from Gore. Pa  
Had a letter from Murdy yesterday
- 23. baked today. The bread looks well not very  
white I am making soap Maun boots 1.25
- 25 Fine day I did not go to church I have a toothache
- 26 I am well today and can hardly get along
- 27 70 3 lb butter 20 = 60 =
- 29 Sent a letter to Annie M. Donnell with <sup>twelve</sup> 12 dollars 40  
for Murdy's board 12

Nov 1884

- 8 Saturday Baked bread bought 1 pkte Curds - 10  
1 pkt wine colour 10. 1/4 lb logwood 10. 1 crochut hook 23  
1 skin B. yarn 15 Candy 5 Tuby 45 Coloured 65  
flannel red Marions hood, 1 cloud. Made  
1 pair of flannel drawers for Marion, Pa  
& Far are making a bridge across the creek  
to go to the barn
- 9 Sunday very fine day I went to church. The  
last sundy for McCallaway for two week

- 1 I missed a week. To 5 lb tea 45 925
- 2 Sunday I did not go to Church today
- 3 my head is sore
- 3 I am baking some pies for the Social  
bought and two jelly cakes
- 4 We had a fine meeting last night  
The Hall was filled to the door we were  
all there 1.60 There were a number 1.60  
of speakers present each one spoke twenty  
minutes. Mr McCallaway was chairman  
Mr Matheson <sup>Rev</sup> Mr Cameron, Mr Peterson Rev  
Mr Hartie Rev Mr Barlie Rev Mr Calder  
& Dr Alguire. it was a test Act celebration  
There was more than 50 dollars taken  
in at the door  
It is very ugly today snow & rain  
Mr McCallaways salt is today Ann &  
I went to wash dishes at the Hall but  
could not get in, we got draggled
