- 4 Woman's Meeting at our house got one new member Mrs R D McLeoman 1⁰⁰ member 12 present I went to the Sidewalk Concert took 6 tickets 1⁰⁰ rained last night 1-0
- 5 Mrs Williamson paid her rent 4⁰⁰ Very fine day Jimmie is ploughing the quilted vest of the Missionary quilt ^{yesterday} it looks well.
- 6 Began to snow about 7 AM and snowed until evening. There fell between 6 & 8 inches James & Dan Sam went both to plough but came home 10:30 and brought the black wether and butchered it he was very fat
- 7 Sunday still snowing about 1 foot on the ground very few in church not more than 35 or 40 no praying the night is wild
- 8 Betty fine day not many on road Sent Mandy 5:10
- 9 Tuesday Mrs Grant & Mrs Dan came and helped me finish the Missionary quilt this is the day of the Lord Mayor of London grand procession rain got Mission boots at Hill 1⁰⁰
- 10 Raining very ugly day I was at Prayern meeting got my feet wet got a letter from Mandy
- 11 Trying to do a little to my new dress Mrs Hunt M.D. came to help at the quilt she was too late
