are not better yet. Menes Rose has it too
W. very fine. a nice shower last night
A took Cather Meighan home this evening
2 A Plowed. Henry Chord. I took 5 bags
Miscel Chop to Br D. & brought home
barley Chop. A.M. I got some Mortar at
M Banky & Bricks at N B. There
Albert Ruser & I fixed Chimney on
Hebron Meeting House & made it some
higher P.M. W. Cagley, but very fine
Sunday 3 all went to Meeting at Hebron except
I remember by C Burkholder sermon on
John 3:8 by Br C Abraham Smith & his
daughter Mary & M. No were here to
dinner W. very fine & clear. East wind. Cook
& Boy Chord brought in Apples from back
Orchard brought some lime from M Banky
& took it to Flavin to make a wall
in his new stable under the Tringh.

A helped Amey Bishop to board up
the front of the new stable just P.M.
Henry grubbed soil P.M. W. cloudy with
a little sleet & snow in the morning
Cloud up P.M. rather cold air
5 A worked at wall at Flavin. Henry Plowed
in Corn Stubble & finished grubbing soil
& I. Navy went to Markham A.M. This
we made some doughnut P.M. W. ground
frost some last night fine & clear
6 Henry went thrashing with Sam Ruser at Sweden
A worked at Flavin. A.M. I Chord A.M. he & A
went to Plowing match in Scarborough P.M.
W. Sharp. Clear. fine & clear
A Boy sorted Potatoes (we put the most of them
into the south sheppen when we dig them
they have not rotted much) & A & Henry
took Separator apart & cleaned it
it runs very easy now. I Chord then
A plowed P.M. I took 6 bags Oats
Chop to Br Q. A.M. took 5 bag barley
P.M. went to Cedar Grove & brought out
chop home W. Slight drizzle. This morning
Cloudy. Cool today. The Corn Stubble pretty
A finished plowing. After dinner he went to Whittaker
Pail and Blacksmith Bills a small one
B & C Blinn & one to N Miller. I & Henry
sorted some Potatoes. A.M. Henry took at
Flavin's stable P.M.
