Fine day cloudy and sunny. I scuffled
 potatoes and turnips on crops in a.m. Willie
 hauled three more loads broken stones from
 Enarie road work finishing it. I thinned
 some more turnips in P.M. We cut some
 more hay in No 7. Willie got 3 pulley at
 Beath's \$1.00

Wednesday

Fine sunny day. Mr Bass and Jim
 Fernal here all day thinning turnips. I
 scuffled with Jess in a.m. Willie down
 town in morning took 120 lbs potatoes to
 Armstrongs and got 100 lbs black barley
 chop at 1/2 ds both in a.m. got at Mills meat
 45 ds. Willie cut more hay to-day in No 7
 and raked in P.M. I hoed turnips in P.M.
 We drove up to Skevles Belmont road
 with Jess in evening to see horses etc.
