We drove down town at night with Jess got at foots grocier 25cts medicine at Armstrongs for Sophia - fish from Lou 40cts

Fine day cloudy and sunny. I scuffed potatoes and turnips oranges in AM. Willie hauled three more loads broken stones from Quarrie road work finishing it I thinned some more turnips in PM. We cut some more hay in H.O.T. Willie got 3 pulley at Beattie \$1.00

Wednesday

Fine sunny day. Mr Bass and Jim Fernal were all day thinning turnips. I scuffed with Jess in AM. Willie down town in morning took 120 lbs potatoes to Armstrongs and got 100 lbs black barley chaff at 1.25 both in after got at Hills meat H.5cts. Willie cut more hay to-day in H.O.T and raked in PM. I hoed turnips in PM. We drove up to Skechers Belwood road with Jess in evening to see horses etc.
