1 Tuesday

 thaw. New Years Day.  
 Father Mother and Uncle Jim up for dinner  
 Robert Craig up after dinner to see how  
 the White sewing machine we got from  
 him on trial was working. Mrs Milne  
 and Ross Berse Helen and Jean up for  
 tea and evening. I drove them down Lucy in cutter.

2 Wednesday  
 Cloudy. mild. not very frosty. Willie took  
 Besse down to Wm Deans and brought back some  
 fanny that I took down on 31st Dec. In PM we  
 spread with spreader one load in No 1 and 2 on  
 No 5 pasture field 3 loads to acre. Mr Bunting  
 over in PM calling. We hauled in some com.

3 Thursday  
 Rain last night and more or less all day  
 icicles hanging on trees heavy laden very slippery.  
 We out corn in AM and A Shortreed and Wyle  
 came up before noon and brought 3 steers  
 Peter, Mike, and Dick. at 5 cts we took them  
 down they weighed 3880 @ 5 cts \$194.00  
 weighing 15 cts. In PM we did sundy jobs inside.
