Tue 27. Fine but mostly cloudy thunder storms passing all around us

Wed 28. Rainy this morning but clearing off quite fine the rest of the day

Thurs 29. Another fine day very warm a very light rain tonight

Fri 30. Very hot day, Jane brought home the necessaries for the picnic today. Born to Mr Jos. Lane. a girl
