- 22 the Revd Mr Tapin preached in the school house & the Revd Mr Carroll in the Church
- 23 Storming all day there is no travel on the road
- 24 the road is brock through our fields they come in at at John Sabers gate & down his field till they came to Eds road then across our fields & out at the gate at the house
- 25 the Revd Mr Carroll preached in the Church David & Bive came here to night Albert & Lela came also Mr Jean & Mrs Jean Mr Bilton & Mrs Bilton & daughter & Mrs Croshaw
- very cold day no work done
- 26 Daved & Bive Albert & Lela Ed, Billie Ellen Albert & Bive went all to spung this afternoon the weather is a little milder cold
- 27 I took care of the cattle cold day
- 28 the Revd Mr Ash preached in the church this morning he is a theslam minister the is giving a description for Victoria College the Revd Mr Baker reads the Schoolhouse in the evening
- 29 Ed saw 20 bushel of oats from John Sabers
- 30 Ed went to Garrison with the full team to the woods and brought with a roller & Mrs Bilton
