23rd fine day I quilted for 3 hours I brought out two bags of flour & some cracked wheat

24th Mr. Smith came from Kingston last night he ^{was} a student he preached at Faerfax this morning

^{lay with} ^{little} James McMullen took him up he preached here at night & then went to Gouanawee to go to Kingston afterwards Mr. Brown preached in the morning

25th very cold day I did nothing only take care of the cattle Hugh Elling ^{came here on Saturday}

26th I went to Kingston on the Express ^{to} ^{express} ^{went away on the} attend the Presbytery fine day

27th I went to Speeridge for some seed barley

28th got home on the Express this afternoon from Kingston there was a large amount of business to do & I slept at the City Hotel heavy rain all day

29th frost last night I quilted I got home to night he Braugh a load oats with him

30th Tommie gathered rags we boiled all day there was a good deal of it

31st Mr. Glesford a student preached this morning Rev. Mr. Brown at night fine day
