Got in three more loads from the orchard this forenoon which makes fifteen in all so far. The weather continues to be very warm. 86° in the shade. Some appearance of rain in the north but not here yet. I have almost finished cutting the field back of the barn. Got the last part of it up to night.

We have been working in the hay again to day with all our might. Got in six loads from the field back of the barn, making twenty one. Finished cutting this morning and this afternoon raked and put up balance of field. There has been some appearance of rain this afternoon, in the North, but after all it has kept off. The weather has become still warmer than yesterday. Thermometer at 89°. Am thankful to be making such good progress with the haying.
