Consolation Ice opened at the Little Island 6th helping George
at Old M^{ts} making for 8 troughs George kept the Rest of the
On the 8th trees to day Running mudlugwell snowing some
in Montreal very cold Drifting Windy 7th Boiling Sugared about 4
then Taken from Williamstown and I fishing 2 lbs got 4 Lost one he went in the hole
from Williamstown 8th Splitting the Birch and Ash Logs at the River
On this day split a Basswood for Rails Sugared about 4 lbs
the Plaud to day Began to snow heavy to night skinned the calf Seen
James Ho^{ts} swallow for the first cranes came grasshoppers
Wood 13th we heard night hawks 9th a very fine day Sap
Went to Little Island running well put out the canoe for the first
time day 14th we went to the Sturgeon Island Randolph and I
digged about 33 lb Peggy and George crossed Left them
in canoe at Hammonds Island Briton and I gathered
about 15 rails about 60 pails of sap in the Barrel to
night then the Barn to the River and the Jumper to the Barn
opening slowly 12 Years Married to day

Made some troughs for London in the swamp and
lapt some soft maple Trees running well 14th
George Renshaw here had a Bottle of Good stuff John
Gray and his 2 Brothers here fishing 2 lbs about all
night got 4 2 lb from John Gray Sugared 2 Mole 3rd
2 Basins London and I chopping some wood for the
Raining Thunder and Lightning to night the fire
Vimeter we had this spring 15th John Gray went
high Wind calm and foggy Raining hard Made
it in M^{ts} asses and crossed Peggy and Pete came
Back emptied the troughs cows wanting to
to the Bush Broke the ice at the shore
Prying it up and the wind Rose in the night
and made a great clearing Rewts or Perry
came they come Regular every year and hatch
2 times in the Barn I see a Wild Goose
every day flying alone he must be a stray or
Lost his own flock ice Broke well to day
from the Light house 16th a change in the
Moon this morning Fixing the Fence at the Pig Pen
Windy Froze hard last night Keeping on the Cow
Took the Canoe up to the Door
