at Steels thrashing all day. I trimmed  
turnips in A.M. and in P.M. took another  
load turnips down 248 bushels got 1980 weighing 30

thunder and lightning. I was at Bob Lindels  
thrashing to day. Willie pulled in turnips etc  
put up crop and gave to Frost for Armstrong 772 lbs

in P.M. rain and hail flurries at times windy.  
Willie at Steels thrashing all day.
