- 22 Began to rain today and is raining yet 4 P.M. He had to kill the Dam Cow today she was putting out her inside bird writing to Sandy Hugh Ann came last night and gave me a present of a white apron
- 23 Sabbath School entertainment. Quite a large gathering of people. The children done well. There was a Mr Carson from Montreal who gave an object-lesson to the children. He had a number of candles and tallow & wax and compared their light to Christians, and showed how drunk would put out a Christians light - "by putting a bottle over the flame of the candle"
- 24 I was trying to make a little soap today
- 25 Had tooth ache all night. I went to church thinking the Prohibition petition would be signed
