Willie took one cherry log (No 6) and 2 ash logs (No 2) down to Watsons to get cut into lumber and brought back with him 353 ft of scantling etc. Mother up in P.M. Bella drove her down in cutter. Lizzie M. Donald up for tea and evening. No 155 R.M. had a lamb to-day a ewe one.

Raining and freezing trees coated with ice got colder in P.M. mist cleared away and sun came out thawed ice on trees got very windy at night. Willie cleaned and oiled harness today I worked at putting water tank together I made it shorter cutting rotten ends off and put on new bottom. I went over to mouse at night to reception by Mr & Mrs Crow. There were not many there.

Mostly cloudy, frosty but thawing some Willie finished harness and went down town in P.M. took some of the harness down to get mended got box matches 13. I finished tank. Willie down town at night. paid harness 35 on 15th
