in Wisconsin @ 27¢ per lb @ 1.40 Gran Sugar 50. 1/2 @ 13  
brown sugar 25 - cash 50. candy 2. we had potatoes, squash  
& eggs & fresh biscuits for supper Paul cut up most of  
wood Alex brought - I boiled 3 pots of feed for the first  
Sat. & Hill went after a load of coal. Marjorie baked  
bread & cleaned the kitchen. I peeled the peaches for  
presses or made 3 pumpkin pies & swept the dining room  
ironed a big crummy after dark & boiled 5 pots of  
pig feed two for tomorrow Mary Jane brought our  
mail Paul swept the school house & drew a barrel of  
water at night took up her bee hives not much honey  
Jan & I was terribly sick all day & such dreadful  
pain in my head. Fannie came home Bertha & Hon  
Marjorie boiled two pots of mush for the pigs they  
have all gone to church from the other hoast a good  
turn out of little folks. Missionary meeting made 1/16. 25

Mon 9. Terrible hot all day on the sun but cool for  
house. fog last night. I got much wind Arthur  
& Paul sheathing at Tom's the Nevins dishes got @ 1.00  
Paul 50¢ he drew a barrel of water after he got  
back. Hill went after another load of coal. Marjorie  
washed the cows & I washed dishes swept & boiled  
pig feed & churned & washed the churn & lot of  
milk crocks that I skinned I don't feel able to  
drag after being sick Paul has let the hogs get  
away & the lot he got <sup>left</sup> find her  
& took the honey out 3<sup>rd</sup> on one of good honey & 15' in  
the other of good honey quite a lot. he got through  
the colander  
Tue 10. beautiful day Marjorie & Paul went after  
corn to the John Law's got 10 bu @ 30¢ per bu. 73 00  
they gave her 2 baskets of peaches & grapes  
she took a roll of butter in Hester's 6<sup>th</sup> @ 24¢ 1.20  
& 9 eggs 17¢. put 111 on the book got butter 1.15  
dome of lead 3. plug tobacco 5. Hill & Arthur over  
& we had peaches & cream before they left  
I dug carrots & potatoes for supper. got the  
cows up & milked them the trustees had a  
meeting at the school house he talks with  
the teacher the is going away Friday  
I got a lot of wood on & Paul helped I  
boiled a lot of feed for the pigs  
Wed 11 rammy part of the day. made the roads  
awful muddy I went down to sweep & dust  
washed west horn & cold set the calves in until after
