- 5 Fine day. Fine sunshine. but high wind Tom Heenan's old barn on the Fraser farm, fell this morning it had stood many a year, I got 3 lbs cheese 37cts. 3 lbs green sugar 26 3/4 lbs brown sugar 22 1/2 pan bread 25. 1/2 lb tea Black, 25=
- 6 The Womens B. F. M. met here today 9 members present not counting the women of the house, 1 visitor gave 25
- 7 Fine day. Drawing wood for furnace
- 8 Finished wood
- 9 Heard that Kinzie McDonnell died suddenly last night. got 1 pan bread yesterday 25cts
- 10 Kinzie was buried here today
- 11 Sent a letter to Far
- 12 I went to Prayer Meeting. The village was in great excitement at the drowning of John Jack who fell in behind the Glenco House. Another victim to the traffic.
- 13 McKillop, bard, gave an intertainment in Heptabah. a good many present, last night ~~we~~ we were all there
- 14 Wet today
- 15 Pretty fine in morning Murdy & I went to Flora Dugls and had dinner, enjoyed the visit it rained & snowed was very unpleasant we got home about 5 PM. got 1 pan bread
- 16 Ugly day, not many out. Rev M. Litch preached
