- 20 I was helping John Dunsen to move up to C. A. Mcneils Bay good sleighing a terrible blustering day
- 21 I was helping Charly Horton to draw Hay from the farm 65
- 22 I was helping Roliphonston to draw wood an but straight to 65
- 23 another very stormy day with Rain & snow and wind the Roads are very soft
- 24 I was drawing from wood all day the sleighing is the best I had Roliphonston the after morning 95
- 25 I was helping Roliphonston to cut wood in the woods to a good sleighing 35
- 26 a very fine warm day I was out in South Crossbar a very nice day
- 27 I came home from uncle Coads this morning to saw wood 20
- 28 I was helping Roliphonston all day to cut wood 65
- 29 I was helping Roliphonston all day to cut wood 65
- 30 a terrible cold day I did not go out 75
