PM cloudy day. We spread 11 loads manure on No 1^(spr) & this AM finishing what was plowed Willie clipped 2 sheep. PM Willie drove to C.P.R. station for cutting harness got it all but one gang

14 57 paid duty \$11.23 freight \$3.19 he got at Mennies staples 10 lbs Phillip's camphor 5 cts Sunflower seeds I worked at moveable house for cows went over to other team in low waygon got boards

Wednesday

Another wet day. raining at intervals all day, exceedingly wet seeding. Willie chopped and I made part of moveable hog house. PM we plowed 2 furrows bottom of No 5 and D.R. hauled 3 loads earth to lane let water out of field into the ditch. Ross Milne and his mother Nellie up for tea. A lamb had a lamb this morning Willie clipped it.

Thursday

Cold cloudy day drizzling at times a stiff of snow last night. Willie dug down in blocked drain in No 5 next D.S.R. also clipped the last 2 sheep this AM one of the sheep had 2 lambs this morning the last 6 lambs we have 16 now. I spread 9 loads manure on sod No 1 for corn (spr). PM Willie took 7 bags chop to mill also went to C.P.R. station to see if gang had come but it hadn't. he didn't get chop back either. Mary went down with him she walked up after tea. she went along home also got at Russell's goods in apr \$1.69 I plowed sod No 1 for corn P.M.
