continued Wednesday forward  
 very warm. Peter Clark told us in morning that our sheep had been in some gardens down at his place they have been on the road for some time getting under the wire fence. I fixed the fence to-day from creek at S.D. up to top of No 5 O.S.R. pulling out stakes and letting the fence down and filling up hollows with earth. We raked up rest of yesterday's cut hay soiled it also cut 12 more rounds. Willie went down brought up 7+M in morning got wheat at Ellis \$1.50 on a/c Jim Robinson and wife Bell up for P.M. and tea. Willie drove 7+M down at night.
