FRIDAY 23

(235-130)

It was a nice day I helped Archie Jack up the house the boys and I drew in a load of Oats after supper the threshing machines started up to day 1918 It was quite a warm day but windy we drew up Oats out of the field at the end of the lane we went up to Mr Adams in the evening

SATURDAY 24

(236-129)

It was very windy I helped Herbert and Willis Vaulallen to thresh It rained about noon 25 It was showery Ada went to church in the morning Mr Owen preached the children and I went to Sunday school Fred and Robert took Laura to Winchester in the evening Mr Jimmies and Chrisses was up 1918 It was quite dull it rained a little we finished drawing in our Oats Fred & Laura went out to Mr Webb's
