Thursday & Friday it stormed wild I don't know when it changed but it is not very stormy today.  $\frac{1}{2}$  lb. leaves = 5¢
- 2 Sunday I went to Church not church, preaching was in the Hall
- 3 Monday Elizabeth got her dress from Montreal today by express cost her 40 cts. 30. express 10 stage
- 4 Elizabeth & I and Far went to see Aunt Kate. Mary is still alive but very weak
- 5 Mary Mc Intyre came there last evening Elizabeth went off today
- 6 Mary & I went to Prayer Meeting Jimmie is bad with toothache and head ache. we are going to Cornwall tomorrow. Aunt Annie & I have to go to receive our legacies
- 7 We went to Cornwall Peter John Ferguson drove us Duncan & Jimmie went with us. Jimmie had four teeth filled and the dentist tried to pull a loose tooth but could not he broke it off. the filling was  $\frac{1}{2}$  lb. 47¢
- 8 I got  $\frac{1}{2}$  lb. of Interest on  $\$7.00$  = Bonus at Kirkpatrick
- 10 yds shirting 100. 12 yds checks 20¢. 1 neck tie 50 354
- 1 pair B.K. gloves 100. 1 silk Kerchief 75 cts 1 watch 100 275
- 3 yds Cashmere 1.35 = 2 yds silks 44. 2 1/2 yard lining 37 2.16
- 1 doz spools thread 4¢ = at drugists Hall 100 = 100 1.58
- 1 doz lemons 25 music 5 30
- We paid  $\$2.50$  for the team 75 cts for dinner
- 8 It is well we went yesterday to Cornwall for it is storming. Evening a great deal of snow got syrup 20 cts ginger 5 cts 26
- 9 Sunday still storming Hardy & Partridge 25 each 50
- 10 Stormiest until midnight it cold today 10 1 bottle Electric oil at M. Kenes 20 15-80

- 11 Raining we will have a flood. To syrup at Dan's sent a letter to Sandy. 4 cts 25
- 12 Wednesday a row at School P.J. teacher & assistant master H.D. crossed woods. very fine day sunny in the morning, afternoon sunshine, warm wind
- 13 Jimmie very bad today. Had Mrs. Corie helping me to wash. had two weeks clothes<sup>7c</sup> yesterday. got at 1/2 ad vis 2 1/2 yds cotton 12 = 30 - 2 lbs sugar 10 = 20 50
- at Dan's paper pins 5 cts. 1 needles 5 = 10 10
- I was at Auntie's this evening the roads are very bad I got 1 bottle Follows Compound 11 phos. 1.25 = 1.25
- at J.A.'s. Paid above 75 cts. for 6 lbs honey 75
- 14 Got a copy of John's Will from Legate. for Annie & I. 50 cts each 50
- News of the war in London. General Graham's forces Captain O'Brien's camp routed his forces. his loss 4000 killed 6000 wounded. British loss 70 killed 100 wounded a terrible battery explosion at Pocahontas. W. Va. on the night of the 12 March. over 150 supposed to be killed
- 15 Beautiful day. To dried apples 25 cts Black strap 25 cts 51
- 16 Another fine day I was to church, a very good sermon by Mc Gillivray. Jimmie Mc Rosy daughter was buried yesterday Ronald Mc Ronald Grant's daughter will be buried tomorrow both deaths consumptive
- 17 Monday. St. Patrick's snow and slush but not cold. tall young folk with green ribbons To 2 loaves bread yeast 15. Sold 2 doz eggs at Willis 11 cts = 44. paid an old account of Murdy's of 26 cts = 44 cts and the eggs = 86 86
