- 22. Fine day, but windy. Muddy and I went to the woods very bad cathots. Some holes ridlings. Uncle Donald is not well. we got home at 7 P.M.

- 23. I did not go to church. Pa is not well. I went in evening to see Mrs Ellis who lives in Mr Ennis farm house and who is ill of typhoid fever Cecile McLeaman called to see us. He came home on Friday from Alaska. Jimmie went to Martintown to see Uncle Hugh who is very poorly
- 24. Jimmie left this morning for Montreal to attend Temperance Convention
- 25. Bird and Muddy went to Hephzibath Sabbath School social held in St Andrew's Hall. To look up the school
- 26. Jimmie came home today by the mail. I was out sold 3 1/3 doz eggs at Wilkie. paid 25^{cts} for spec treats I got, to go to sacred concert. 1 lb tea 25^{cts} Lamp chimney 10. and 23 cts cash

Birdie and the boys went to spend the evening at J. C. Mowat's
- 27. Fine day, Uncle Donald. Dan and Mary were over. Pa went to see Aunt Kate. Burrett showed the roads are thawing
