

 - 13 Fine nice day. The children walked to Vincent's but did not get many berries.
 - 14 Fine. The children got 5 qts of berries at Jenner's patch. I made part of a dress for Violet. Charlie went to a dance at Kurrshaws.
 - 15 Fine. busy as usual. Children went to Church in the morning and Geo & I in the evening. George went to see Mr. Hill & had tea there.
 - 16 Fine afternoon. Children went to Church in the morning and Geo & I in the evening. George went to see Mr. Hill & had tea there.
 - 17 We were going berry-picking with the Thomses but it was too wet. In the evening Geo & Eva & I went to Thomses and Eva walked over to Vincents to see get some eggs.
 - 18 Showery. We washed. Mrs. Sullivan and Mrs. Johnson called in the evening.

- Aug. 19 Louie's birthday. She had a party in the afternoon. Jessie Thoms came with Wallie. Mrs. Richardson called, also Miss Rice and Miss Robertson. Charlie & they are busy decorating the hall.
 - 20 Fine day. We all went to the concert, it was quite a success & \$34 was realized.
 - 21 Fine. The children & I went picking black-berries & Geo went to Utterson. I went in to Chester's to say good-bye fer to Mrs. Shaw. Charlie went to Huntsville.
 - 22 Fine nice day. George went to Huntaville and we went bathing with Miss Rice.
 - 23 Sunday. Fine but cool. Cyril Thoms came. I called at Atkinson's in the afternoon. Eva & I went to Church in the evening, & I played. Mrs. Body was at Church.
 - 24 Fine & hot. Geo & the children & I went berry picking behind Schwaoob's (?) but did not have time to get very many. School started.
 - 25 Cold and wet. Geo went to Utterson.
 - 26 Fine, we washed & I went to Ladells in the cance. Violet & I got a few blackberries:
 - 27 I was busy ironing. did not go to practice. Geo went up the Lake to Bradley's.
 - 28 East wind & like rain. Charlie intends going on the midnight train to Toronto. Mr. & Mrs. Atkinson called.
 - 29 Gloomy & cold. I went to Ladells.
 - 30 Showery. I went twice to Church and played the organ not many at Church.
 - 31 Brighter but we had heavy rain in the afternoon, which stopped us from getting to the blackberry patch. I went on the lake in the evening.
- Sept. 1 Fine. I washed. Geo went to Utterson. He & I had tea at the parsonage.
 - 2 George poorly. Charlie came home. Mr. Fox & .
 Miss Seargant & Mr. Atkinson called in the evening.

- Sept. 3 Charlie went on the 5 o'clock train this morning to Rainy Lake. Olive has a bad cough & is restless at night. I ironed.
 - 4 Gloomy. hot morning but turned cool. Geo & I went over the lake to Fathers to get crabs.
 - 5 Fine & cool. Geo went to Utterson this evening. the Shaws are up again. Like frost.
 - 6 Fine & cool. Geo took Louie & me over to Thomses & we walked through to see Mrs. Rumball. came home to tea. We had a very good sermon from the Bishop in the evening.
 - 7 Labor Day. children at home. Fine with cold nights.
 - 8 Like rain but blew off. I washed.
 - 9 Sultry. rain at night. Busy ironing. I went up to Ladells in the canoe.
 - 10 Man called wanting us to buy a stove. hot morning but turned cooler. children had a bathe.
 - Il Lovely bright day. Busy all day. Miss Rice & Miss Maguire came to tea but Mr. Fellowes did not come. Miss Rice & Miss gaguire & I had a paddle after tea. Miss Rice brought her Phonograph over here.
 - 12 Fine morning. We went on Gem to Huntsville. It rained hard for a little while. Father came back with us. We had a nice trip both ways.
 - 13 Fine. I went to Church with Father & Louie & Kathleen in the morn. Lucy came and drove Father home in the afternoon. I played in the even.
 - 14 Gloomy with a little rain. I made Eva a skirt.
 15 damp morn but it cleared out and then came up a big thunder storm with heavy rain after I hung out the wash. I called upon Mrs. Pope(?). Sultry.
 - If I managed to get clothes dry enough to iron.

 Ernest Winter came just in time for tea. Rain came on & continued all night so he stayed. The 3 girls went to Galls.
 - 17 Wet again today. The children came home in the afternoon. Much cooler. We have missed the cow two days.
 - 18 Got cow at last. Finer but a few showers with a little dash of snow.
 - 19 Lovely day but cool. Eva & I called to see Mrs. McClure & baby. Geo went to Utterson.

- Sept. 20 Lovely day. I drove to Johnson's with Herbert Ladell. got home late.
 - 21 Beautiful warm day. The Gall's did not come but Mrs. Thoms & Louie did.
 - 22 Beautiful day. I washed & after dinner Geo & I took Miss Rice up to Hill's in the Canoe & had a very pleasant paddle.
 - 23 Fine morning but turned cold & wet in afternoon.

 - 7 Wet day & high wind. Winnie & Jack Roper came in for shelter from the rain on their way from Brymer's in the evening.
 - 8 Still unsettled & wet at night.
 - 9 Cleared out fine towards evening. George & I went to a farewell party at Ladells for the Ropers.
 - 10 Fine. Eva & I cleaned her room. Mrs. Atkinson called. Geo went up to see the Ropers off.
 - 11 Nice day. I went twice to Church. We expected Chas home for his birthday but he could not come. Cyril Thoms called.
 - 12 Lovely day. I washed bedding. Daisy Geall called to get Eva's dress to make. Northern Lights were very bright tonight.
 - 13 Lovely day. we washed.
 - 14 Fine again. Lucy drove Ethel & Marjorie over to stay.
 - 15 Thanksgiving day. Fine day but wet at night. We had a Fowl supper in the evening which passed off well & \$28 was realized. Mrs. O'Hara called before going to the hall.
 - 16 Showry. The children are having holidays. I cleaned the pantry. Mrs. Kealty called. Geo went to Beatrice with Will Johnson.
 - 17 Showery & mild. Geo Thoms was here to tea. Charlie surprised us by walking in about 10 p.m.
 - 18 Cold & gloomy. George & Charlie went to Thomses & stayed for dinner. They brought Cyril back.to tea. A little snow. Ethel & Eva & I & Charlie went to Church.
 - 19 Charlie went off by an early train this morning. Gloomy day. I cleaned dining room.
 - 20 Fine but cool. Ethel & I washed.

- Oct. 21 Lovely day. George & I went on the "Gem" to Huntsville. I went to Forrest's.
 - 22 High wind. Busy ironing. Ethel & I called at Chester's in the evening. Rain at night.
 - 23 Ethel & I cleaned sitting room. I went & got some wall paper. very cold.
 - 24 Fine & sharp. Busy all day asusual.
 - 25 Fine nice day. but there was a big windstorm at night. Mabel Forrest is staying at Brymer's.
 - 26 High wind with flurries of snow. Ethel & I papered sitting room & put furniture back in it. Geo walked to Sandy Mitchell's.
 - 27 Snowed all day. I went to Ladells. Geo went to vote. Mahaffy got in. Geo Thoms was here to tea. Mabel Forrest & Annie B. called in the evening.
 - 28 Lovely day. George & I went over the lake to Father's & got home to tea. we expected the Miss Thomses but they did not come. Mrs. J. Rumball called.
 - 30 Another nice warm day.
 - Rain this morning but cleared & Ethel & Marjorie went home by the "Gem". Wallie L. came to play with the children & they were out in the evening playing by moonlight.
- Nov. 1 Sunday. Mr. Atkinson had his house painted last night. G & I & Louie & Olive went over to Thomses & had tea.
 - 2 Fine nice day. I was busy all day. Geo went hunting. Eva & I went to see McClure's baby who has been ill.
 - 3 The Atkinsons are making a great fuss about their house & have a constable over to find out the culprits. Lovely weather.
 - 4 Warm day, hunters got no deer. Connie & Louie
 Thoms came to tea.
 - 5 Weather changed last night & it is blowing very cold from the North. G. did not hunt.

- Nov. 6 They hunted but got nothing. Louie & I cleaned Kitchen.
 - 7 Geo went hunting with Brown & they got a deer. Got Kathleen a pr of boots how long will they last. Eva & Louie are at Chesters for tea.
 - 8 Sunday. A fine day I went with the children to SS but none of us went to Church. Cyril called in the morn.
 - 9 A lovely day. I cleaned hall. After dinner Louie & I walked to Vincents. Windy at night. Charlie came home after we were in bed.
 - 10 Windy & cool. Charlie went hunting with his father but got nothing. The Chester boys were here for tea.
 - 11 Fine but high wind, I washed & baked. Charlie went back this morning early. Eva commenced music lessons again.
 - 12 G. went hunting again. I ironed.
 - 13 Cold with flurries of snow & wind. G. went hunting with the Thomses. Mr. Hill came & took his apples away.
 - Snow this morning which has continued all day. Will Geall was here grading ground. George went hunting & his party got 2 deer which winds up the season.
 - 15 Sunday. fine. The children & I went to SS. Eva & I went to Church at night. I played. very few there.
 - 16 Cold.
 - 17 Geo went to Utterson & sold 2 cutters. Milder I went to Ladells.
 - 18 About a foot of fresh snow & it snowed all day.
 I finished washing. Geo went to Utterson & sold
 another cutter. He stayed for oyster supper &
 got home early next morning, cold.
 - 19 Fine day. I ironed. Geo went to Bracebridge & Met Mr. Robinson, Allan McInnis Killed pig, cold snap. Kathleen is home poorly, Louie also, has a sore eye.

- Nov. 20 Thermometer at zero this morning.
 - 21 Milder. Geo spent the day at Utterson. The Str. "Sem" was burnt at Huntsville.
 - 22 Mild & cloudy. The children & I went to SS. & G & E & I to Church. very few there.
 - Soft snow fell. turned cold at night, 23
 - 24 Colder. Geo went to Utterson. The remains of the poor Gem were brought home. The Chesters are packing up to move to Huntsville.
 - 25 Very cold morn. I finished washing. In the evening Eva & I called at Chesters.
 - 26 Geo went to see Mr. Hay. Willie & Jack came to tea.
 - Nice day but sharp. George went to Utterson to sell 27 a cutter. I went to Ladell's. Mr. Atkinson called.
 - 28 Geo went to Utterson after dinner. The children came to practice & the Quigley's stayed to tea. I paid Mrs. Chester for Eva's music lessons.
 - 29 Milder. I went to SS. but only George went to church. Geo Thoms was here for tea.
 - Snowy. George pulled the plaster off our bedroom ceiling. Mr. Smith called in the evening.
- Dec. 1 The children are all at home as the teacher is sick. We washed. The sleighing is very good & the snow seems to be staying.
 - 2 Allan McInnis put the paper on our room ceiling.
 - I cleaned out the room & put up the bed.
 - Geo walked to Falkenburg & stayed all night. nice weather.
 - 4 A little fresh snow fell. The children went to tea at Mr. Smith's. George went to Bracebridge & got home tonight. I went to see Mrs. Chester about the telegraph.
 - Mild & stormy. George went to Utterson.
 - 6 Roads wereheavy. I did not go to SS. but went to Church at night.
 - 7 I went to Chesters to do Telegraph Report.

- 8 Henry Gall was here to dinner. Snow keeps coming. Dec.
 - 9 The Chesters moved to Huntsville today. night.
 - 10 Mrs. Gall & Henry & Louise came to tea. Cold but turned snowy.
 - Very stormy roads heavy. Geo had Mrs. Theobald scrubbing the store ready for goods to go in.
 - One load of Groceries arrived. Stormed all day. 12 George sold cutter to C. Jenner.
 - 13 We went to S.S. as the snow plow had been through but it stormed again at night.
 - About a foot more snow & cold & clear. we put away 14 some of the goods in store.
 - 20° below zero last night it is frightful weather for so early in winter about 3 ft snow.
 - 16 Got 2 bags flour.
 - Cold & fine. Girls came to practice songs.
 - Nice day. Mr. Hill was down to the store. We went to Pres Xmas tree it was very good.
 - Mr. Thoms was here to tea. I had to stay at the store while Geo went to Ladells to help audit Cheese books.
 - Stormy again about a foot of fresh snow. Sun. The snow plow made a track so we went to S.S. Geo only went to Church but there was no service.
 - 21 Mild, more snow, Allan McI. began to make partition in the store. The children had their last practice here for tree.
 - More snow. The children & I went to Xmas tree at Mr. Smith's, had a job getting Olive home in the snow. Edna Addison stayed all night.
 - 23 I washed & was busy generally.
 - 24 I ironed & iced Christmas cake. Charlie did not get home till about 3 in the morning.
 - 25 A dull Christmas no service & too much snow to go out, turned cold at night.

- Dec. 26 Very cold 25° below this morning. Geo went to Utterson. Cyril Thoms came to tea with Charlie Wall & Nita Thoms called in the evening.
 - 27 Sunday. The children & I went to Sunday S. Stormy afternoon. We did not go to Church.
 - 28 37° below zero last night. cold again tonight.
 - 29 Charlie went back to Rainy Lake. Geo went to Utterson. Noon.day.
 - 29 Milder. The children spent some of their Xmas money at Ladell's. Eva & I went up in the evening.
 - 30 Fine & cold. we washed and dried the clothes in the house.as usual.
 - 31 Not so cold. Annie Lawrence came before dinner while John took a grist to the mill.

1904

- Jan. 1 The New Year came in with a blustering N. wind & it turned very cold. nothing going on but work there is plenty of that. There is too much snow & cold to go anywhere.
 - 2 Cold & gloomy. Geo. sold our cow to Mr. Balls and took her away. Eva tried skating a little while. cold night.
 - 3 Sharp day I did not go out as I did not feel very well.
 - 4 Very cold. one can only try to keep warm this weather.
 - 5 37° below zero the last 2 nights & still-wery-eeld but it is moderating. I went to Ladells in the afternoon.
 - 6 Mild, I washed, baked & scrubbed. Mr. Oldham was here to dinner. Getting milk at Joneses.
 - 7 Got clothes dry in the house. Geo cleaned dining room pipe.
 - 8 A few more inches of snow this morning. George cleaned the snow off the roofs. There was no school this afternoon. Edna Addison came for a while.
