Treatment of Otitis Externa.

R. M. Nelson has found a mixture containing five per cent. each of phenol and ichthyol in glycerin remarkably efficacious in the treatment of otitis externa diffusa, myringitis, otitis externa circumscripta ("furuncle of the canal"), and, in connection with other treatment, as good as any ear drops in acute otitis media. The mixture proved especially effective in otitis externa caused by and complicating chronic suppurative otitis media, and in general, was particularly valuable where ordinary methods, after careful trial, had failed to give relief. It was applied on cotton tampons.—J. A. M. A.
