- Thur May 29. Fine but strong cold wind. Mrs Davidson and I for a walk in evening. Painted back verandah. 8 hours this year last time
- Fri May 30. Fine but N.W. wind cold. Auntie and I in Toronto Mrs Davidson and I at "Shore" for Velma Grice. girls called
- Sat May 31. Fine and much warmer. at Grave-yard in eve.
