- Sun Oct 28. Fair and turning very cold, I went to morning church and for a drive with the James, and there for tea at Annie's for the night, little fire in furnace yesterday and to-day, Mr D. lighted them.
- Mon Oct 29. Fair but very cold, clothes froze on line, Mrs Davidson picking apples, I took old black coat to be pressed at R. Hill called at Misses Page, some sleet and little flurries of snow.
- Tue Oct 30. Fine and bright after a very heavy frost last night, I went to Toronto, called to see J. Cook at Hospital.
