- 29 Very fine day. Sandy Pa & bride were in
Church. Brid got a hat for Marion 1.60
- 30 Brid Marion Jimmie Ram & myself went to the
pic nic to day. we spent a very enjoyable
time not many there out side of the
lodge got bread after we got home 25
