- 25 Ad drew a load of wood from Armstrongs
- 26 Ad drew wood from Armstrongs David Johnston  
& a Sularon boy helped him he drew 6 loads
- 27 drew 2 loads of wood I attended the cattle
- 28 the Revd W. Francis preached in the morning & night
- 29 very high winds last night Ad went for a load  
of lumber to Northbrook for Mr Enosis our side  
Road at the gate is filled up from fence to fence
- 30 drew some dung to the corn field from day
- 31 Ad went to look at lot No 15 in the 9 concession  
of Sanseloume it belongs to John Miller  
he wants to sell it came home went to go  
sintlands to go to Sun & see the 11 & go to Brock  
Ellen went him Aunt Belony is very bad
