Mary took butter over to M^cVicars in morning with Lucy in buggy got at Mills meat 43 at Foots groceries 25 from Miss Gibson for butter 40 Willie went up to Allans got 6 bushels of Malvern peas. In P.M. we hauled back 2 loads manure from cattle stables to pile I killed and skinned sick sheep put carcases in bottom of heap. Mr Munn called paid for manure 20 Put coal oil on cows to-day to kill lice.

Fine sunny day strong east wind Mother, Father, Uncle Jim and Marjorie and Jessie Ross up for dinner and tea. We pruned orchard etc. (Besse had 13 pigs to-day) 2 more lambs

Saturday

Rainy heavy all A.M. gradually cleared off by night. Roads very bad. We put harness in wagon to take back to T.L. field to harrow but were stopped by rain. We cleaned barn and granary floor in A.M. and in P.M. hauled back to pile one load from pig house and 2 from cattle stables of manure. I went down town at night in buggy got at Nichols bolts for reeder 15 changed down lock 5 at Armstrongs 1/2 gal coal oil 35 also on apr grass seed (see apr) at Steels shoe polish 25
